GRADE 3 PARENTS:

SEND WHITE "T" SHIRT ON FIRST DAY

Although our Grade 3 Hebrew Name Service will take place on Sunday, March 25, 2012, we have much to prepare within our Hebrew Name unit of study prior to that date.

- Students will learn the English meaning of their Hebrew name and will learn to write their name in Hebrew.
- Students will make their own Hebrew Name "T" Shirt, that they will wear for the 3/25/12 service.
- Students will also make a Hebrew name bracelet that they will wear to the service.

Please send with your child, ON SEPTEMBER 12, FIRST DAY OF RELIGIOUS SCHOOL, a clean, white "T" shirt with no other decoration on it. Please label the inside of the collar with your child's first and last English name.

The Hebrew Name Form, on the second page must also be completed and returned, along with the "T" shirt, on September 12, the First Day of school. **If your child does not have a Hebrew name, or if you cannot recall that name, the family must select a Hebrew name as quickly as possible.**

Selection of a Hebrew name involves deciding upon your preferred criteria for the name:

- 1) Name your child for a beloved relative who has died. Either use the honoree's Hebrew name or the Hebrew translation of the honoree's English name.
- 2) Find a Hebrew name that has the same approximate meaning as your child's English name.
- 3) Decide upon the quality you want your child's name to reflect. Use the Hebrew name translation of that quality, i.e. Hannah = gracious; Simcha = joy.

You can check English/Hebrew and Hebrew/English names in the library or book store *or use the Hebrew name books we have in the religious school office. Just come on in to use them.* You can also research key words, "Hebrew Names" or "Hebrew Names for Jewish Babies" on the internet. Should you have any difficulties researching/finding a Hebrew name, please contact me. I am happy to assist you.
